Applicant must be living in or treated in the seven-county metro area of Minnesota: Anoka, Carver, Dakota, Hennepin, Ramsey, Scott or Washington



Applicant must be in active treatment, including chemotherapy, radiation, bone marrow transplant, hospice, palliative care or surgery.



Applicant must meet the financial guidelines set by Angel Foundation





Angel Foundation grants help with rental and mortgage payments, as well as temporary housing and association fees.



Many recipients choose to receive Cub Foods gift cards to help keep food on the table when funds are low.




